Consultancy on Project Evaluation

Project Background

The CLEEN Foundation is implementing a project to contribute to reducing corruption, promote judicial transparency in processing anti-corruption cases; and enhance accountability in the criminal justice system in Nigeria. The project's goals seeks to make information on corruption and accountability easily accessible (online and offline) to legal practitioners, law enforcement agencies, Judges, Prosecutors, Defendants, government agencies responsible for the administration of criminal justice and civil society organizations working for justice sector reforms, legal scholars and researchers. It also aims to improve the efficiency and impartiality of the judiciary and other stakeholders in processing corruption related cases with respect to the Administration of Criminal Justice System in Nigeria. Finally, the goal is to create awareness on the adoption and implementation of ACJA in Nigeria in relation to corruption and fair trial processes.

Since 2018, CLEEN Foundation has implemented series of project activities towards achieving the goals and objectives of the project. The delivery of the project activities has involved critical stakeholders within the Administration of Criminal Justice in Nigeria, the Police, the Judiciary, the Nigeria Correctional Service, the Administration Criminal Justice Monitoring Committee, the academia, Civil Society Organizations, the Media, Lawyers. CLEEN Foundation has documented identified project results and intend to carry out an external evaluation of the project.

Purpose of this Consultancy

The objective of this consultancy is to conduct an end of project evaluation of “Promoting Accountability and Transparency in the Administration of Criminal Justice System in Nigeria” with support from MacArthur Foundation.

The assignment will cover interaction with beneficiaries and partners of the project in the eight focal states of the project in Nigeria.

- Identify and measure the relevance, effectiveness, efficiency, sustainability and impact of this project in the states and Nigeria at large.
- Review project documents and activity reports
- Develop and submit evaluation report of “Promoting Accountability and Transparency in the Administration of Criminal Justice System in Nigeria” project to CLEEN Foundation on or before the 15th of December, 2020.
- Production and submission of a documentary on the project results.
