INTRODUCTION

The CLEEN Foundation (formerly known as Centre for Law Enforcement Education) is a non-governmental organization established in January 1998 with the mission of promoting public safety, security, and accessible justice through the strategies of empirical research, legislative advocacy, demonstration programs and publications, in partnership with government and civil society.

LOCATION: Federal Capital Territory, Abuja

The CLEEN Foundation works through its headquarters in Abuja and three regional offices in Benin, Lagos and Owerri to implement program and projects across Nigeria and the West Africa sub region. Towards meeting CLEEN's research mandate, the organization is frequently contracting printing services, consisting primarily of documents in form of reports, policy briefs, monographs and books. Thus, through a competitive bidding process, CLEEN Foundation wishes to invite applications from suitable printers to submit quotations for the printing of Gender Audit Report on the Assessment of Protection Services and Shelters for Trafficked Victims and Returnees in the Federal Capital Territory, Abuja.
