

CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR STAKEHOLDERS MAPPING TO SUPPORT EARLY WARNING AND EARLY RESPONSE (EWER) IMPLEMENTATION IN FOCAL COMMUNITIES IN NIGERIA

The CLEEN Foundation (formerly known as Centre for Law Enforcement Education) is non governmental organization established in January 1998 with the mission of promoting public safety, security and accessible justice through the strategies of empirical research, legislative advocacy, demonstration programmes and publications, in partnership with government, civil society and the private sector.

Recently, CLEEN Foundation started the implementation of Village Monitoring Systems on Early Warning and Early Response (EWER) project focused in Northern Nigeria specifically Kaduna, Plateau, Taraba and Zamfara states respectively. The purpose of the project is to prevent and mitigate violence against civilians in at-risk areas of northern Nigerian communities by strengthening and expanding early warning and early response (EWER) capabilities including through access to near real-time alerts of village burning incidents. Given the limitations of existing EWER structures and the slow response by state security actors, mobilizing individual and collective civilian engagement is the best strategy for turning the tide on violent conflict in northern Nigeria.

Hence, the project will train civil society early responders, establish community-derived warning indicators, and share knowledge across EWER networks in order to anticipate, verify, and intervene in violent action by perpetrators.

Location: Kaduna, Plateau, Taraba, Zamfara

Purpose of the Engagement:

The purpose of this engagement is for the consultants to conduct a Stakeholder mapping to support EWER implementation in focal communities and develop a mapping report from the information/data collected from the focal communities.

Duration of Assignment: One week

Requirements:

The Applicant must possess the following:

- A minimum of BSc/BA, preferably advanced degree in Social/Humanitarian/Political Sciences/Development Studies
- Relevant experience in security sector reform, peacebuilding, conflict resolution programming not more than less than 3 years.
- Be conversant with prevailing context of safety and security issues in affected communities within the state.
- Strong analytical and report writing skills
- Must understand the local language.

Roles/Responsibilities:

- Identify and map EWER stakeholders to engage in assessment research that will provide deep local knowledge of safety and security issues in the state and inform implementation of project activities
- Identify Community Safety Partners, which may be local organizations or recognized leaders, from across the four focal states and existing EWER networks who will advise on the interoperability and coordination of the project.

Expected Deliverables:

- Develop comprehensive report on assessment research conducted in the focal state(s).
- Submit report on assessment of research conducted in the focal states
