



CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST TO DEVELOP AN ENDLINE REPORT ON RIGHTS COMPLIANCE IN COUNTER-INSURGENCY OPERATIONS IN BORNO AND PLATEAU STATES

Introduction

The CLEEN Foundation (formerly known as Centre for Law Enforcement Education) is non-governmental organization established in January 1998 with the mission of promoting public safety, security, and accessible justice through the strategies of empirical research, legislative advocacy, demonstration programmes and publications, in partnership with government, civil society and the private sector.

Project Background

The counter-insurgency fight by the Nigerian military and other security agencies in some states of the country, primarily in the northern part of the country, is a welcomed effort aimed at instilling peace and enforcing normalcy in the troubled states. The federal government in response to insecurity especially terrorism, has deployed its military might and created theatres in strategic states for the purpose of mitigating and quelling terrorist attacks in the country.

Unfortunately, there have been several reports of human right abuses perpetuated by some security personnel while defending against insurgency in the country. It was on this basis that CLEEN Foundation decided to carry out two-phase research in Borno and Plateau states to understand compliance to the protection of human rights by security agencies in their counter-insurgency operations. This became evident considering several reports alleging the military and other security agencies of violating the rights of citizens in states where they operate. The Foundation has carried out and reported the baseline research done on the subject matter and is now interested in developing a report for the end-line survey which has just been concluded. To this end, the Foundation wish to get the service of a consultant who will help to develop the report.

Purpose of Consultancy

The purpose of this consultancy is to get the service of a consultant who will help to develop the end-line report on the study carried out in Borno and Plateau states on rights compliance in counter-insurgency operations.
