

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR A CONSULTANT TO WORK ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COMMUNITY POLICING STRUCTURES IN SELECTED PILOT STATES

The CLEEN Foundation (formerly known as Centre for Law Enforcement Education) is a non-governmental organization established in January 1998 with the mission of promoting public safety, security, and accessible justice through the strategies of empirical research, legislative advocacy, demonstration programmes, and publications, in partnership with government, civil society, and the private sector.

BACKGROUND

According to Section 112 (1) of the Police Act 2020, a Policing Committee, also known as Community Policing, should be created. However, the implementation of this provision has been challenging due to faulty conceptualization. Various attempts by different leaderships of the Nigeria Police Force and development partners have been made, but the desired change and partnership between the police and the community remains fragile. To achieve sustainable community policing by ensuring active participation of necessary blocs within the community, the CLEEN Foundation and UNDP are seeking for a credible consultant to establish a Community Safety Forum in selected focal states in Nigeria.

OBJECTIVE

CLEEN Foundation will collaborate with various partners, such as the NPF, UNDP, PORTO, and other organizations involved in the Police Reform Project. The objective is to create a more effective and efficient community policing system that is responsive to the needs of the community. The Specific objectives of this call are:

- ☐ To provide technical and operational support to the design of the community policing structures
- ☐ Establish the community policing structures in the focal states
- ☐ Facilitate the training of the community policing structure

SCOPE OF WORK

- ☐ Strong analytical and report writing skills.
